
Email Validation Server

Current differences to the original concept

- no upload to key servers
- no special signature
- no signature expiry or revokation
- handles any incoming signed mail, encrypted or unencrypted

Nice things

- light-weight and robust approach
- integrates with existing WoT infrastructure
- privacy preserving, no connections between users can be inferred
